Please be advised that the County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health and Quality Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency has received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment per Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), Section 21665(c). This public notice was prepared pursuant to 27 CCR Section 21660.1.

### **Project Description**

Escondido Resource Recovery is an existing solid waste transfer/processing and anaerobic digester facility permitted under a full Solid Waste Facilities Permit issued on December 29, 2020. As a result of the facility's 5-Year Permit Review, the amendment to the RFI, in the form of a Transfer Processing Report and In-vessel Digestion Report, corrects grammatical and typographical errors, reflects in-vessel operations from future to present tense including dates of completed construction activities, and incorporates a description of the organic waste measurements and record keeping procedures required pursuant to SB-1383 Short-lived Climate Pollutants: Organic Waste Reductions regulations.

The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit.
