SECV INC.: Request for San Diego County ("County") Solid Waste Hearing Panel to review the County Local Enforcement Agency's ("LEA") Notice and Order of Penalty Assessment issued on April 1, 2026 for property located at 42748 Old Highway 80, Jacumba, CA ("Property").

Grounds for appeal include: 1) hazardous contamination of Property occurred prior to SECV Inc.'s ownership of Property and County was aware of these conditions, 2) County's prior enforcement actions against previous owner of Property for the same violations, 3) County's failure to disclose to SECV Inc. hazardous conditions on the Property or the enforcement action against previous owner, 4) SECV Inc.'s good faith clean-up and compliance efforts, 5) SECV Inc.'s efforts to work with previous owner of Property and County, 6) COVID 19 impact, and 7) LEA's improper assessment of penalties.
