**NOTICE AND ORDER RE PENALTY ASSESSMENT NO. EA-2026-01 FOR 42748 OLD HIGHWAY 80 JACUMBA, CA 91934, ASSESSOR PARCEL NUMBER (APN) 613-080-40-00; SWIS# 37-CR-0132**

Dear Mr. Attisha,

The Department of Environmental Health and Quality, Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for San Diego County is issuing you a Notice and Order for Penalty Assessment (NOPA) as a result of your failure to take the necessary corrective actions to comply with LEA directives.

Specifically, the site remains in violation of Public Resources Code sections (§) 45000.5(a) and (§) 44002(a)(1) for operating a solid waste disposal site without obtaining a solid waste facility permit. Additionally, the site remains in violation for failing to submit a corrective action plan (plan), designed and stamped by a California-licensed civil or environmental engineer, and a Community Health and Safety Plan by LEA-ordered deadlines.

Upon noncompliance with the time schedule set forth in the NOPA, the LEA will assess administrative penalties in the amount of \$1,392,000 (\$750 per day in violation). The LEA has the authority to issue you the attached NOPA pursuant to Section §45011 of the Public Resources Code. Please note that the issuance of the attached NOPA does not preclude the LEA from taking further legal action to ensure that the violations will be corrected.

A written request for a hearing before a local Hearing Panel concerning the administrative civil penalties being assessed against you may be submitted to the LEA within fifteen days of receipt of the attached NOPA. However, the appeal would be strictly limited to the conditional assessment of the administrative civil penalties and final compliance deadline, not the stipulations contained in the final corrective action orders previously issued by the LEA that you have failed to meet.
